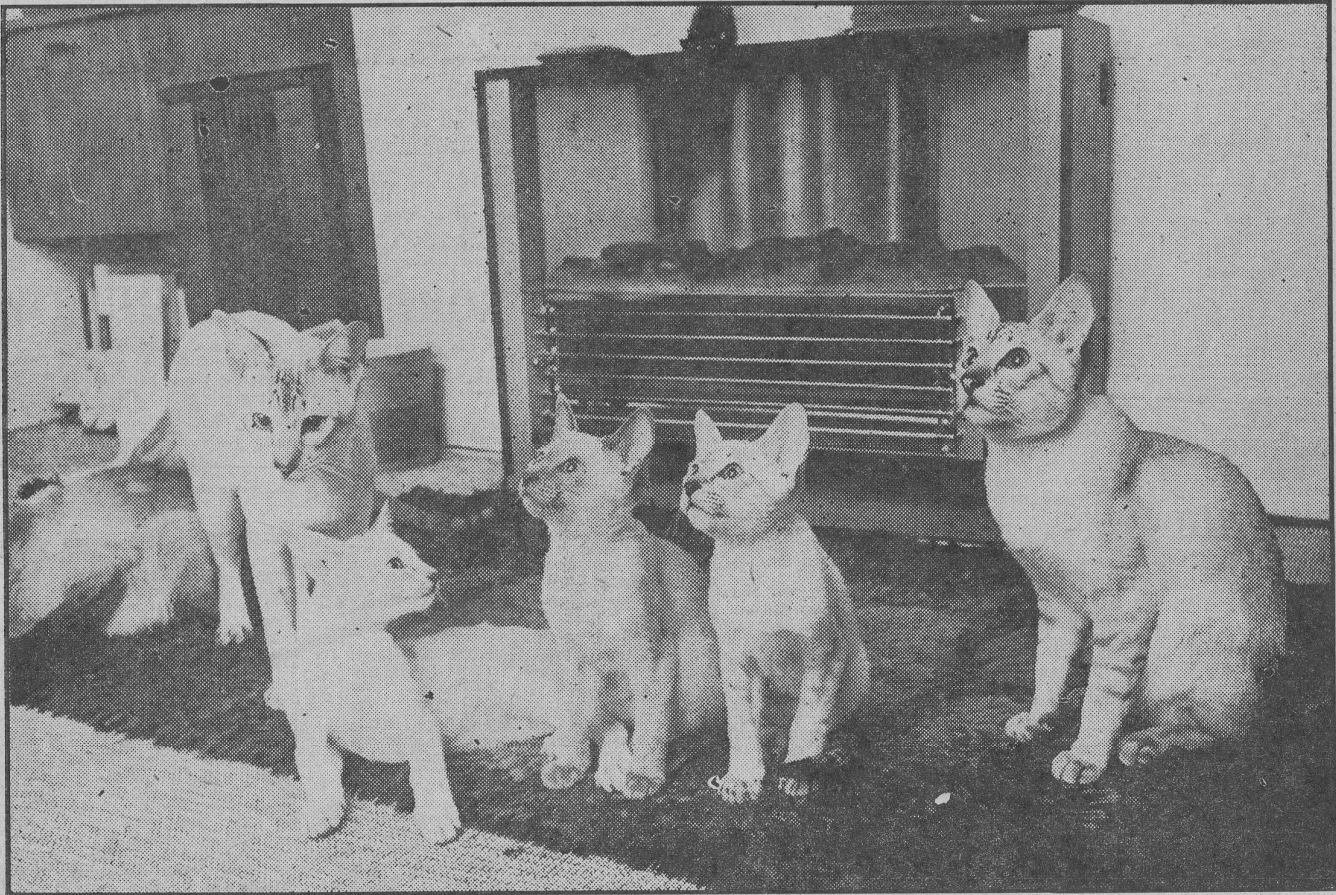

I was pleased to find a remarkable improvement in the quality of the Siamese as compared with the past few years, and if this first glimpse is anything to go by we should see some beautiful cats during the coming season.

A lovely Blue, I admired her very much 2 Waitman's Deebank Vigilant Shah, handsome Blue male of excellent physique, wonderful bone, soft coat of medium length, very well groomed, just a little shady, excellent broad head with very neat ears, gorgeous eye colour and excellent type, short broad nose and good strong chin, very hard lines indeed

to meet winner **AOC LH Ad 4:** One abs 1 Galt's Hilldeu Golden Shadows, well named, gorgeous Blue Cream female, excellent broad head with neat well tufted ears, lovely eyes, very short broad nose, good firm chin, lovely expression and a really outstanding coat of pastel shades intermingled on face, head, ears, body, legs, feet and tail, most beautifully groomed. My best cat, I see she won first in all her classes and was later in the day the unanimous choice of the judges for best in show 2 Shaw's Springheels Pheobus, Cream male, coat of beautiful texture, very well groomed, unfortunately rather light at the roots and showing slight bars, very neat top of head and tiny ears which he holds well, beautiful eyes, broad nose, nice type. In lovely condition 3 Hale's Tykeland Yvette, Blue Cream female with a lovely long soft well groomed coat, rather more blue than cream, unfortunately, which made her coat seem rather dark, nice type with lovely eyes of good colour, good top of head and neat ears, beautiful condition, lovely temperament **AV LH Kitten 4:** Two abs 1 Galt's Hilldeu Triumph, exquisite orange eyed White male kitten with one of the loveliest coats I have seen, very long and pure white, beautiful texture, just like swansdown, congratulations to Mrs Galt on Triumph's excellent presentation, very good broad head with neat, nicely rounded well placed ears furnished with very long tufts, bold eyes, colour not yet developed, excellent type and very cobby with good bone, short, very full brush, a most promising kitten and my best kitten in the Longhair section 2 Galt's Hilldeu Lotus, Blue female kitten, litter sister to the winner, again most beautifully shown, superb long, soft, very even coat of lovely texture, excellent top of head with neat ears, good eye shape, colour not yet developed, not quite such short nose as the winner, good chin, very cobby and again excellent bone and condition **ANY VARIETY Breeders LH Cat or Kitten 4:** One abs 1 H Golden Shadows 2 H Triumph 3 H Lotus LH Neuter: 1 Rennie's Chantelle Hamurabi, Cream male with long, soft well groomed coat, unlucky to be light at the roots, and on chest and tummy today, very good broad head with neat, nicely tufted ears set well apart, lovely eyes for shape, size and colour and really gorgeous type, excellent short broad nose and wonderful chin, very good bone, a pleasure to handle 2 Gjersoe's Hilldeu Lucky, Blue male, nice type and eye colour and with a perfect top of head, exceptionally neat ears, long coat of excellent texture groomed to absolute per-

fection, congratulations Mrs Gjersoe on Lucky's excellent presentation, a cat of excellent physique and lovely to handle Litter LH or SH: This was a difficult class to judge; I should have liked to have given them all first 1 Dalley's LH litter of two blue eyed Whites, one male and one female, and one orange eyed White female, all very cobby and with lovely long pure white coats, exceptionally well shown, nice type in all three, the orange eyed White being the best at present, a very lively litter which provided the public with much entertainment 2 Keen's excellent litter of five attractive Siamese which ran the winners close, nice even litter of well grown kittens, three females and two males, accompanied by their lovely good tempered mother 3 Cox's Brown, Burmese litter of two males and one female, also accompanied by their lovely mother, again a nice even litter in beautiful condition which showed in their short fine glossy coats which is such an attractive feature of the Burmese Local Class (Liverpool Residents LH Cat or Kitten) 5: 1 H Golden Shadows 2 D Vigilant Shah 3 H Triumph r T Yvette Radius Kitten, Male or Female: 1 H Triumph 2 Taylor's Lorelei Dorinda, a beautiful Lilac Point female kitten, ran the winner close, I placed her second only because of her round eye shape, lovely head, type and eye colour and beautiful pale coat, very short, fine and close lying, nice slim legs, good long tail.
